Robert Morris Elementary School Relocation Plan

Good afternoon Robert Morris Families and thank you all for your understanding and patience as we ensure the smooth transition of Robert Morris Elementary students to John Adams Elementary and Neil Armstrong Elementary. We understand your confusion and frustration but we believe this is the safest option for students and staff to ensure their continued safety.

Effective tomorrow, May 17, 2023, Kindergarten, First Grade, and Life Skills students will report to John Adams Elementary located on Capouse Avenue.

Second Grade, Third Grade, and Fourth Grade students will report to Neil Armstrong Elementary on North Lincoln Avenue. All students will remain with their Robert Morris teachers and will have dedicated classrooms assigned.

Transportation To and From:

Transportation will be provided for the families of Robert Morris if they so desire. All students who choose to use District transportation will be picked up and dropped off at Robert Morris Elementary. The details are as follows:

Pick up:

- School buses will arrive at Robert Morris by 7:50 AM
- Buses will depart Robert Morris Elementary at 8:00 AM and transport students to John Adams Elementary or Neil Armstrong Elementary
- School staff along with security personnel will be present at Robert Morris Elementary to assist with student arrival

Drop off:

- Buses will pick up students at John Adams Elementary or Neil Armstrong Elementary
 - \circ $\,$ Classroom teachers will assist with dismissal procedures
- Students will be transported from Adams or Armstrong to Robert Morris Elementary
- Parents should pick up students at Robert Morris Elementary at 2:20 PM
- School staff along with security personnel will be present at Robert Morris Elementary to assist with student dismissal

Parents who choose to transport students to and from either John Adams or Neil Armstrong should plan to drop off by 8:10AM at Adams or Armstrong and arrive for dismissal by 2:10 PM (1:45 PM on Tuesdays). Please reference the included drop off and pick up information for building specific procedures.

Students who receive specialized transportation will continue with their current transportation through our contractors.

Regarding the arrival of students to Adams, buses will take Sanderson to Ash St. route. Buses will enter the building through the Ash St. entrance. Staff and Parents are to utilize street parking only.

Students who arrive late to school will need to provide their own transportation to their respective school and check in at the main office.

Curriculum and Instruction:

Curriculum and instruction will continue for all grade levels and all title interventionalists and ELD services will continue. Related Arts programs will continue as well.

Student Belongings:

Robert Morris Staff will be transporting student's personal belongings to the appropriate building. Smaller desks and tables for Kindergarten students will be taken from Morris if needed.

Food Service:

Aramark staff previously assigned to Robert Morris will be relocated to John Adams and Neil Armstrong to assist with the impact of the increased enrollment on food service operations. School breakfast and lunch will still be served and at no cost to the students through the Community Eligibility Program. The Fresh Fruits and Vegetables Program will also continue.

Special Education/Life Skills:

All services will be provided as they have been since the beginning of the school year. Transportation pick up locations and times will remain unchanged for Life Skills students. Learning Support grades K-1 and all Life Skills will relocate to John Adams Elementary School. Learning Support grades 2-4 will relocate to Neil Armstrong Elementary School with the Case Manager.

Security and Safety:

School Security Officers will be detailed to support student movements at Robert Morris and John Adams during arrival and departure on Wednesday, May 17 and until the transition period is complete. Additionally, a full-time SSO will be assigned to John Adams for the remainder of the school year.

Mental Health:

Scranton Counseling Center is moving the CSBBH team from Morris to Adams and Armstrong. One Behavioral Health Technician will go to Adams, one Behavioral Health Technician will go to Armstrong, and the Mobile Therapist will float between the two buildings. No disruption of services is expected. The School Counselor from Morris is shared with Adams. She will continue planned lessons and meetings with students at Adams and Armstrong through the end of the school year. Contracted district Social Workers will be available to assist at Adams and Armstrong.
